Dear Residents

You may know by now that the Vivly Living application was submitted into Kirklees, on 24th December. It currently awaits validation, and when it is validated it will go out to public consultation. As far as the information allows we believe that it is likely to go to public consultation in three to four weeks, but we can't be certain of this. But when the consultation period begins we need as a community to act quickly and object strongly.

What we can tell you is that Vivly Living's application is an outline application for 123 houses. Typically, an outline application seeks approval for the principle of a development and does not show detailed plans.
